**The Forum will be held in the Palace and Park Complex  
of the former grand-ducal estate of Georgiy Mikhailovich Romanov in Kharax  
(Gaspra).**

To participate in the Forum there are invited researchers working in the context of political science, social philosophy, international relations, sociology, history, psychology, cultural science, ethnology, linguistics, economy, geography, law and other scientific directions dealing with multifaceted aspects of the announced theme.

The Kharax Forum is the international platform for the academic discussions devoted to studying the latest tendencies in the development of Russia, the countries of the former Soviet Union and also world political, economic and sociocultural processes.

The Kharax Forum is held annually, two times a year – in May and October and begins its own history in 1997 when more than 300 participants from 15 countries of the world gathered in the City of Yalta.

**Articles prepared on the basis of the reports read out at the Forum will be published in the journal "Philosophical Sciences" with placement in the system of the Russian index of citing (RSCI) and also in the international base of identification of scientific information DOI (Digital object identifier). The English-language version of the journal is indexed at the Web of Science platform.**

For the publication in the printed version of the journal the articles in the Russian and English languages are accepted, also publications of the parallel text of articles in the Russian and English languages in the electronic version of the journal are possible. The editorial board reserves the right to reject an article from the publication if it does not meet the requirements.

**Travel and accommodation are at the participants' expense.** The estimated cost of accommodation is from 2000 Russian rubles a day. Accommodation is carried out by the participants of the Forum independently. The recommended accommodation: Dnepr Sanatorium <http://dnepryalta.com/ru/>

**The registration fee for the participants of the Forum (speakers) makes up 5000 rubles. The registration fee for the coauthors, listeners, correspondence participants and accompanying persons makes up 3000 rubles.** The registration fee is meant for payment of the expenses connected with rent of the hall and the multimedia equipment and also other expenses connected with holding the Forum. The participants of the Forum are given a certificate.

**The Forum participants will be offered excursions about the Palace and Park Complex of the Southern Coast of the Crimea (Livadia palace, Vorontsov Palace in Alupka, the Palace of Alexander III in Massandra), the excursion to Massandra Winery with tasting of the best Crimean wines, the visit to the Nikita Botanical Gardens, the visit to A.P. Chekhov House Museum in Yalta, the excursion "Orthodox Temples of the Southern Coast of Crimea". ### **Requirements for publications**

The articles are accepted for the publication in the Russian or English language. The submitted articles shall have a title, the data about an author (authors), summary (200–250) words and keywords (5–10 words) in the Russian and

English languages. Data about the authors shall include a surname and name (full form), the place of work, an academic degree and a rank, home address, phone and e-mail, the identifier in RSCI (SPIN code) and ORCID.

As a rule, the volume of materials should not exceed 40 thousand characters with spaces. It is extremely desirable that the full text of article be in two languages: Russian and English. The Russian text is for the publication in the printed version of the journal, and English – for the electronic English-language version of the journal, and, in special cases, also for the printed version.

In the text of an article the references to the sources shall be given in square brackets, and the notes and the quoted literature issued according to GOST R 7.0.5-2008 – shall be given in the end of the text. An article shall contain sections "Quoted Literature" and "References" in which the list of literature is given in the Russian language and in the Latin alphabet respectively. The examples of issuing citing and the list of literature see in the journal.

The list of the quoted literature for fuller justification of an author's position shall contain, as a rule, more than 20 sources. It is strongly recommended that the results of the modern researches published in the international English-language journals be used. Responsibility for accuracy of the provided quotes and data is taken by the Authors of the materials.

Authors are recommended to send additional information about themselves and his/her photo which will be uploaded to their personal page on the Journal website, and in certain cases, and in the printed version.

The text of article shall be structured and contain Introduction, thematic sections and Conclusion.

### ***Rules of Quoting***

**REFERENCES** are a bibliographical list in the Latin alphabet. It includes only those works which have been mentioned in the Notes, and not obligatorily all of them. In this list the Russian authors' surnames are transcribed, the foreign authors' surnames are given in the original form. It is also desirable that the foreign authors' work titles be given original one or in translation into English, but it is desirable that this translation be generally accepted. The titles of works by the Russian authors are translated into English. The names of publishing houses are transcribed, it is possible to give English translation in brackets. If a reference is made to the book, the total of pages in it shall be specified. If the reference is given to an article or work as a part of the collection, page numbers which are covered by the article in the journal or collection (unlike the Notes where references are given to the page with which the quote is taken from) are specified. If the source is in Russian or is translated into Russian, it is also specified. Pay attention that in the list in the Latin alphabet the signs //, / or dash aren't used.
